South Arkansas Brass is a new ensemble making it's debut performance here at the 1987 Four-States Bandmasters Convention. We consider it an honor to play for this convention.

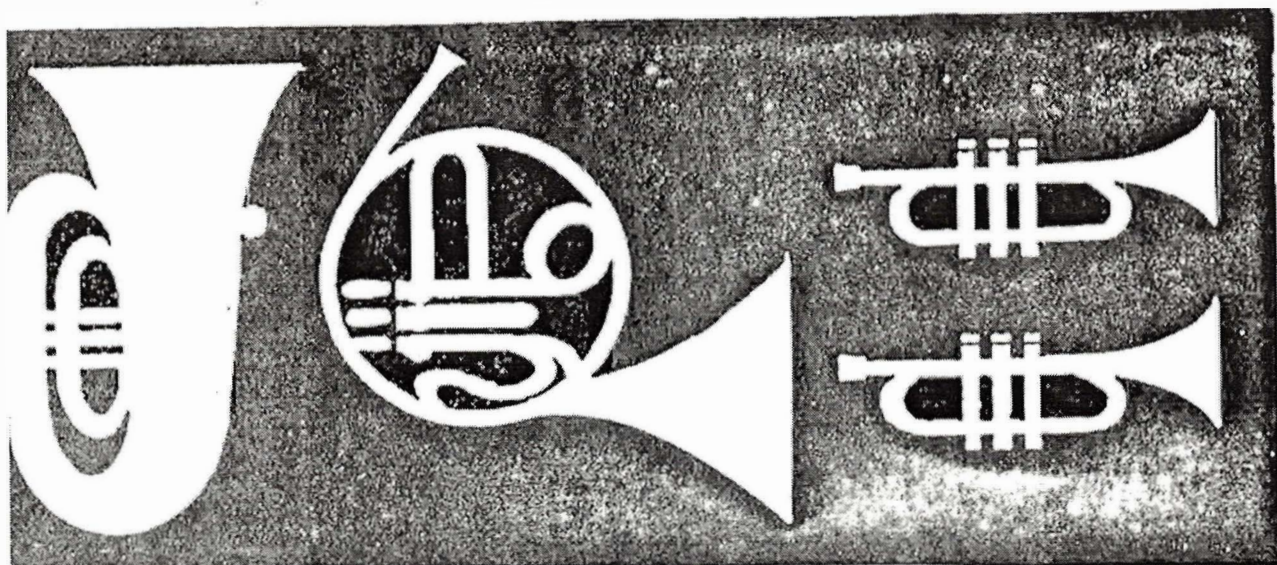

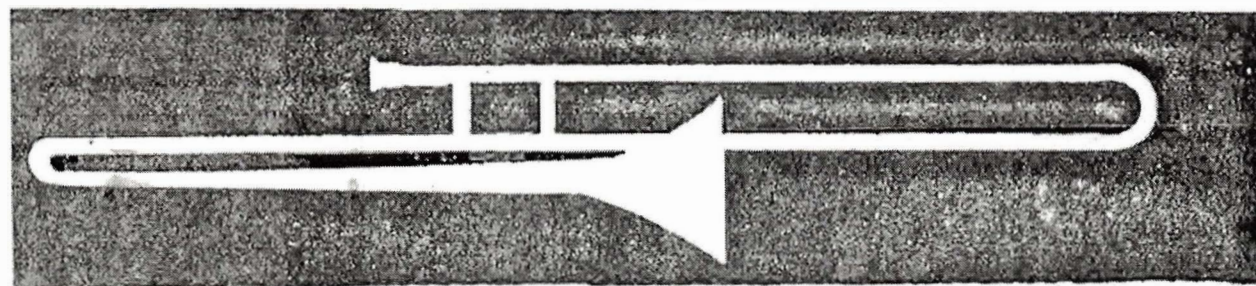
