

**Kokopeli**, the flute player, was a great *mahu*, or legendary hero of the Hopi. He is said to have led the migrations through the Southwest, the sound of his flute echoing through the great canyons and cliffs. In this piece, I have tried to capture some of this sense of spaciousness, and of the Hopis' deep kinship with this land.

Although the rhythms are carefully notated, performers are encouraged to play with some freedom. Lengths of notes and pauses will vary in different acoustics and circumstances.
