Wayne Bergeron is one of the most active players in the world. Born in 1958, Bergeron grew up in Southern California where he started on French horn before switching to trumpet in the 7th grade. Bergeron took to the trumpet quickly. "I found I had natural ability for playing the trumpet in the upper register at an early age." In 1986, Bergeron landed the lead trumpet position with the Maynard Ferguson Band. He can be heard on such MF recordings as "Body & Soul," "Big Bop Nouveau," "Brass Attitude" and "The One & Only Maynard Ferguson." Maynard had this to say during a radio interview: "Wayne is the most musical lead trumpet player I've ever had on my band."

As a sideman, Bergeron's list of CD credits reads like a who's who in contemporary jazz and pop, running the stylistic gamut from Ray Charles to Green Day. Bergeron has worked on 300 plus TV & motion picture soundtracks. His featured trumpet solos can be heard on the motion pictures *Rocky Balboa*, *The Incredibles*, *Leather Heads*, *The Perfect Game*, *High Crimes*, *Rounders*, *Hey Arnold (The Movie)*, *The Rat Pack*, *Aladdin*, *King of Thieves*, and *Foolproof*. Numerous TV credits include shows such as NBC, ESPN & TNT sports themes, Academy Awards, Emmy Awards, Grammy Awards, Latin Grammy's, *Family Guy*, *American Dad*, *King of the Hill*, *Futurama*, *Buzz Lightyear*, and *Hercules*.

Bergeron's first solo effort "You Call This a Living?" earned him a Grammy nomination in 2004 for Best Large Jazz Ensemble and rave reviews from fans and press worldwide. Wayne's latest recording "Plays Well With Others" (Concord Jazz label, 2007) is being met with the same acclaim.

Bergeron's passion for big bands has led to his inclusion in some of Los Angeles' most well respected bands. He has recorded with Quincy Jones, Gordon Goodwin, Arturo Sandoval, Pat Williams, Sammy Nestico, Jack Sheldon, Tom Kubis, John La Barbara, Ralph Carmichael, Ray Anthony, Buddy Childers, and Bill Watrous.

Bergeron is co-designer of the YTR-8335LA trumpet and YFH-8315G Flugelhorn. Bergeron enjoys his work as a clinician/educator and feels it's important to "give back" by mentoring young musicians.

As a member of the SUNY Fredonia class of 2003, Benjamin earned a B.M. in Music Performance and studied jazz and conducting. During his time at Fredonia Ben was an active member of both the Wind Ensemble and College Orchestra. Originally from Wilson, New York, Ben moved to the DC metro area in 2008 after winning a trumpet position with "The President's Own" United States Marine Band. This prestigious group of musicians performs concerts and ceremonies throughout the capitol region, and has the unique musical mission of providing for the musical needs of the White House. Dr. Albright completed his Doctorate of Musical Arts at the University of Michigan where he also earned Masters Degrees in both Trumpet and Chamber Music. While living in Michigan, Ben held positions in many area groups including the Lansing Symphony, the Saginaw Symphony, the University of Michigan Faculty Brass Quintet and the Michigan Chamber Brass. Ben also has performed with the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra under the direction of JoAnn Falletta and Marvin Hamlisch. He has played for concerts broadcasted on National Public Radio and can be heard on two recordings for Naxos featuring the music of Aaron Copland and Ottorino Respighi. In addition to his busy performance schedule, Dr. Albright serves on the faculty at American University.
